Probationary Enrollment

New Vision International School has the right to put newly enrolled students on academic or disciplinary probation. This policy is in place to protect our students, staff, and school.

Prospective students will be interviewed and their previous school records will be reviewed by the admissions staff. If the students previous school records indicates poor academic achievement or a consistent disciplinary issues, the student could be placed on academic or disciplinary probation for a period of time.

During the probationary time period, the student may be asked to leave the school at anytime for any reason. However, once the end of the probation period has been achieved, the student will receive full enrollment status.
